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Each year, the Governor's Office of Planning and Research (OPR) conducts the Local Government Planning Survey to create a directory of local planning agencies and to compile the latest information on what local planning agencies are doing. Through the survey, OPR identifies the recent planning activities and accomplishments of local governments. Special issues of concern to city and county planning agencies are also highlighted.

The 2000 edition of the *California Planners' Book of Lists* contains the results of OPR's 1999 planning survey. The *Book of Lists* contains practical information that is useful to all local, regional and state planners and resource managers. This publication contains directories of California's city and county planning agencies, Councils of Government, Local Agency Formation Commissions, CEQA judges, and selected State and federal agencies that interact with local planning agencies. It also contains a table summarizing the status of local general plans, including the dates that these plans were last updated. This reference source identifies the local jurisdictions that have adopted plans, programs, and ordinances that may serve as models or examples for others.

In the coming year, OPR plans to improve and expand the usefulness of the *Book of Lists*. Planning agencies will soon be able to electronically update information regarding their communities through an interactive *Book of Lists* that will be available at OPR's website. This will reduce the need for paper survey forms and create a "virtual" *Book of Lists* that will be updated continually, rather than just once a year. We plan eventually to include new interactive features with the *Book of Lists*, such as the ability to generate personalized reports from the data. For those planning agencies that are not equipped to submit information electronically, OPR will continue to provide support in updating the *Book of Lists*.
