

Montague Water Conservation District CEQA Notice of Exemption

The project proposes to release water to the Shasta River from Dwinnell Reservoir and/or a groundwater source located at or near the base of Dwinnell Dam (herein after termed released water) to provide water to the City of Montague. MWCD is expected to release water at up to 1.5 cubic feet per second.

Released water would then remain in the Shasta River for approximately 24.5 river miles to a proposed point of diversion. At the proposed point of diversion, the released water would then be diverted from the Shasta River via an intake structure including a CDFW/National Marine Fisheries Service approved fish screen. The water would then be delivered to a pump station or wet well where a 75 hp pump would then divert the released water to the City Reservoir via a 15,000 foot long pipeline composed of 10" diameter pressurized pipe. Easements for the pipeline will be obtained from private landowners. See attached map.
