Appendix G IV(d)	Change the question to, [Would the project]: d) Interfere substantially with the movement, or the habitat that provides for the movement, of any native resident or migratory fish or wildlife species, including but not limited to, movement within or to a) wildlife corridors, b) breeding sites, c) year-round or seasonally used habitats, d) foraging locations, e) water sources, and f) fish passage sites? Substantial interference may include, but is not limited to, creating an obstruction, fragmenting or altering habitat, polluting habitat with chemicals, light sources, or other pollutants, and diverting water flow.
