The California Electric Transportation Coalition (CalEETC) appreciates the opportunity to provide comments as the Commission works to help protect California from the devastation of wildfires while ensuring the state's energy infrastructure is resilient and reliable.

CalEETC supports and advocates for the transition to a zero-emission transportation future as a means to spur economic growth, fuel diversity and energy independence, ensure clean air, and combat climate change. CalEETC is a non-profit association committed to the successful introduction and large-scale deployment of all forms of electric transportation including plug-in electric vehicles of all weight classes, transit buses, port electrification, off-road electric vehicles and equipment, and rail.
